<u>Our employees should notify and disclose to SSUSA the following:</u>

- If you travel to or have traveled out of the state or country for personal or business reasons with in the last 21 days
- If you have any symptoms such as fever, sore throat, or flu like symptoms
- If you have tested positive for COVID 19
- If you have recently been exposed to anyone that has tested positive
- Any changes in contact information including phone, email and address.
- If you have any concerns at all on the job or at the client site.
- If you are calling off work for any reason as per our policies and procedures

We are asking that during the COVID-19 that all our employees follow our attendance policy and policies and procedures set forth in our onboarding and client orientations. Contact the office if you would like a copy of our current policies and procedures from your onboarding.
